We are excited to inform you that we have started the phased opening of the Temple. The Temple is currently open on Tuesday and Saturday Evenings from 5:30 to 7:30pm. At this initial stage, we are only allowing silent Darshan. We have installed an air purification system and are implementing a number of precautions to protect worshipers, volunteers and pujaris. There will be no pujari present nor Aarti conducted. Worshipers will also be asked to follow guidelines outlined by us. Worshipers that are unwilling or unable to adhere to these requirements will not be able to enter. Assuming that things proceed smoothly and the community COVID-19 case trends remain positive, we will expand hours and loosen restrictions.

PHASE-1 TEMPLE VISITATION GUIDELINES

- 1) Masks covering nose and mouth required all times on premises.
- 2) Worshipers must complete a questionnaire and information form as well as have their temperature taken prior to entry.

Visitors deemed high risk may be denied admission.

- 3) Darshan time will be limited to allow all worshipers a time within the visitation window.
- 4) Only the front door will be available for entry and exit. Backdoor will be locked.
- 5) Restrooms and social hall areas are closed and will not be accessible.
- 6) Worshippers will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
- 7) Worshipers will be asked to follow social distancing guidelines. Markers have been placed in the worship hall.
- 8) Worshipers will not be allowed on the altar.
- 9) Worshipers are asked not to bring any offerings, prasad or flowers.
- 10) We will not be distributing Prasad.
- 11) We strongly recommend that those having underlined health conditions should refrain from visiting temple.
