We are excited to inform you that we have started the phased opening of the Temple. The Temple is currently open on Tuesday and Saturday Evenings from 5:30 to 7:30pm. At this initial stage, we are only allowing silent Darshan. We have installed an air purification system and are implementing a number of precautions to protect worshipers, volunteers and pujaris. There will be no pujari present nor Aarti conducted. Worshipers will also be asked to follow guidelines outlined by us. Worshipers that are unwilling or unable to adhere to these requirements will not be able to enter. Assuming that things proceed smoothly and the community COVID-19 case trends remain positive, we will expand hours and loosen restrictions.

Amendments & Vote Notice

As a result of COVID and the associated closure of the Temple, many Trustees will be unable to meet the event participation requirement in delineated in Article II, Section 2. (b) of the By-Laws and few Trustee candidates will be able to meet Committee Participation requirements outlined in Article II Section 4 of the By-Laws to stand for election. As such, the ITA leadership is asking the General Body to approve the Amendments which waive the event participation requirement for Trustees; "freeze" the aging of Trustee, Advisory Board and Core Executive Committee terms; and postpone the ITA elections to 2021. The specific Amendments, Vote Notice and Ballot can be found under the "ITA Documents" section of the indiatemple.org. ITA Leadership believes that securing these changes are in the best interest of maintaining continuity of ITA services and programs.

The ITA Election Committee is charged with conducting and overseeing all Trustee Elections and votes put to the General Body. The Election Committee is always comprised of one Trustee, one Advisory Board Member and usually one community member. This year's committee consists of Govind Modi (AB), Samir Patel (Trustee), and Lalit Patel (community member). Because of the limitations of public gatherings and associated health risk, the ITA Election Committee has decided that the Vote to approve these changes will be conducted via mail and/or email. The specific instructions can be found on the top of the ballot which is on the third page of the above referenced document. For the proposed Amendments to be approved, 67% of votes must be cast in favor of the change and at least 10% of the General Body must vote. We strongly encourage you to participate this voting process. Votes must be mailed or emailed by September 27th, 2020. If you have any questions, please contact Election Committee Members (below).

PHASE-1 TEMPLE OPENING GUIDELINES

- 1) Masks covering nose and mouth required all times on premises.
- 2) Worshipers must complete a questionnaire and information form as well as have their temperature taken prior to entry.

Visitors deemed high risk may be denied admission.

- 3) Darshan time will be limited to allow all worshipers a time within the visitation window.
- 4) Only the front door will be available for entry and exit. Backdoor will be locked.
- 5) Restrooms and social hall areas are closed and will not be accessible.
- 6) Worshippers will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
- 7) Worshipers will be asked to follow social distancing guidelines. Markers have been placed in the worship hall.
- 8) Worshipers will not be allowed on the altar.
- 9) Worshipers are asked not to bring any offerings, prasad or flowers.
- 10) We will not be distributing Prasad.
- 11) We strongly recommend that those having underlined health conditions should refrain from visiting temple.
