2020 I.T.A. SCHOLARSHIP

<u>Purpose</u>: To support the I.T.A. community by giving scholarships to graduating senior students who have demonstrated <u>dedication and significant contribution to the I.T.A</u>.

Description: Up to two scholarships worth \$1000 each will be awarded to graduating high school seniors whose families are current members of the I.T.A. Each will be renewable for up to 3 additional years based on meeting maintenance criteria and available funding. The scholarship can be used at a 2 or 4-year accredited institution for undergraduate studies related to tuition or books only.

<u>Eligibility:</u>

- * Applicant's family must be a current I.T.A. member
- Demonstration of engagement at the Temple will be weighed heavily: examples are participation in Balvihar -Youth Program, volunteering at the Temple, participation in ITA sponsored events such as fundraising, cultural programs and community events, etc.
- * Applicant must be a current senior at a local high school with plans to enroll full-time in an accredited 2 or 4 year college in the United States.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Jai Shri Krishna!

It is with great sadness that I report COVID-19 impact has reached South Jersey and it's devastating effects will only become more pronounced as infections rise. We already have some community members that are infected and are fighting for their lives and others that have lost the fight and passed away. For them, I ask you pray for their rapid recovery and eternal peace. For those of you that are vulnerable, as a result of age or a medical condition (as I am), I ask that you stay vigilant and focused. Avoid placing yourself in risky situations even for short window. This disease does not take even a minute's pause and neither can your caution.

We have hundreds of doctors, nurses, other health professionals and essential workers in our community. They and their families are making daily sacrifices. They are on the frontlines, selflessly serving and saving others while exposing themselves and their families to the risks of this disease. They are heroes. Please pray for God to give them the strength and resilience to continue to deliver their best while managing the stress and sadness that comes with situations when their best is not enough. Reach out to them, their spouses and kids with kinds words of appreciation and concern. It is an easy gesture of gratitude for those that are able to sit safe at home to offer those that are facing incredible daily challenges.

For our part, the ITA is continuing to adapt and to find new ways to fulfil its mission during this unconventional time. We have continued to help those that need help with groceries, medicines and errands. We have mailed masks to seniors and community members who need them. We have launched the ITA YouTube channel (<u>www.youtube.com/user/indiatemple</u>) and are broadcasting live Aarti and daily prayers. We are also leveraging this channel to provide helpful educational and social content to seniors and lessons for our Balvihar program. Over 200 people visit the site daily. We are also resuming the weekly Senior meeting over Zoom. On April 19th, we held our first Balvihar session over Zoom. We had 15 classes, 250 students, and over 30 teachers delivering our curriculum live. We are also piloting Free Remote pujas starting this month. If you are interested in being part of our test, please contact Anoo Joshi at (856) 577 3631.

In times of crisis, it is critical for us to contribute to the broader community. Based on this goal, the ITA is partnering with a different local charity every month to bring visibility and raise funds for their cause. We are asking members with the ability to donate to support these charities along with the ITA and a donor that will match at least \$2,500 of member donations. Our hope is that every month, collectively we will raise \$5,000-\$10,000 for these worth causes. In April, we raised over \$19,000 for South Jersey Food bank. I am proud of the generosity that our community has demonstrated and appreciative of the matching donors help. This month, we are supporting Cathedral Kitchen which delivers meals to low income children, elderly and unemployed. Additional details to follow in forthcoming email.

Regardless of the duration of these extraordinary circumstances, the ITA will continue to do our best to serve the community and fulfill its mission.
