ITA GENERAL BODY MEETING & ANNUAL TRUSTEE ELECTION

Saturday November 17th at 1:30 at the Berlin Temple

The ITA will hold a General Body Meeting and Annual Election on November 17th at 1:30. We encourage all members to attend this important event. Please note we have moved the meeting time, day and month to mitigate weather impacts and improve attendance by addressing member concerns about night driving and conflicts with winter travel to India, NFL games and children's school night preparations. The preliminary agenda for the meeting is below:

- ◆ ITA leadership will provide a review of the past year and priorities for the 2019.
- ◆ Trustee Candidates for 2019 to 2021 term will discuss their qualifications and planned contribution.
- ◆ Election will be conducted.
- ◆ Constitution and By-Laws Amendment Vote will be conducted.
- ◆ General Body will be given the floor to ask questions.

2018 By-Laws and Constitution Amendments

As a reminder the ITA is governed by its Constitution which outlines the guiding principles of the organization and By-Laws which provides operating details. Last year with Membership's support, we were able to make significant changes to the By-Laws and position the ITA for the future. In implementing these changes, BOT has realized that additional incremental changes would be helpful. As such, we are asking the Membership to approve Amendments to the By-Laws and to Constitution which has not been revised since 2004. We are seeking your affirmative vote at the General Body Meeting on November 17th. The ITA Executive Committee, Board of Trustees and Advisory Board believe that these changes will allow us to better serve the community. For example, splitting the role of Temple Manager into a Facilities Manger and Pujari Service Manager positions will allow us to be more responsive to Member scheduling inquires and facilities problems; adding a Code of Conduct for Members, volunteers and Trustees will create a more welcoming environment; and clarifying historical election policies and procedures will avoid future conflicts.

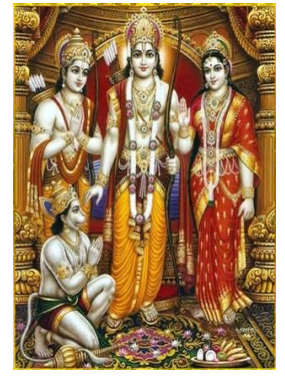

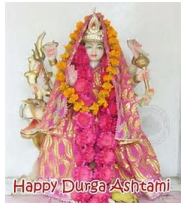

Spiritual Celebration

Importance of Pitri-Paksha Shradha-Tarpan - Every year, an important period of 15 days (Pitru Paksha or Shraadh) is dedicated to the ancestors and forefathers. Pitru Paksha is considered perfect for performing Tarpan rituals. It is believed that the rituals performed during Shradh produces best results for pleasing the ancestors. Shradh occurs right before the Sharada Navaratri in autumn. Like every year, Shradh is coming again in 2018 with a great significance for our ancestors and for us. Shradh marks an important time for performing the ritual of Tarpan. Hindus will perform rituals of Tarpan for their departed ancestors and forefathers this year at our mandir. We will perform Tarpan in Shradh in the way of remembering, giving thanks and honoring the ancestors for all they have given us, the present generations. It is a way of telling them that they are still an important part of our family and they still re-



side in our memories. Period of Shradh is also known as Pitru Paksha. Shraadh Paksha is also a time to offer our prayers for liberation of our forefathers' Atmas Date: Sept.25th to Oct.9th—according to South Jersey Panchang. Matri Navami Shradha on Thursday Oct 4th, 2018; Sarva Pitri Shadha on Tuesday Oct.9th, 2018. 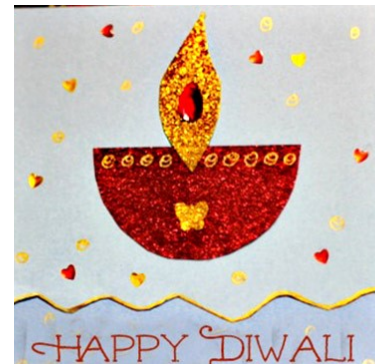

Karak Chaturthi - Karva Chauth Puja

Karva Chauth is on Saturday October 27th.

POOJA TIMES ARE: 3:00 PM, 4:00 PM, 5:00 PM, 6:00 PM

Karva Chauth is a one-day festival celebrated by Hindu married women in North India in which married women fast from sunrise to moonrise for the safety and longevity of their husbands.

Karva means a type of earthen pot of water and Chauth means fourth or fourth day of the dark-fortnight of the month of Kartika.

The day of Karva Chauth is celebrated mostly amongst the entire North Indian community settled either in India and other parts of the world.

The most important aspect of this day is that a dawn to dusk fast is undertaken by the North Indian ladies and seeing the moon they finally break the fast. The Karva Chauth fast is unique perhaps because nowhere in the world does a wife go without food or water just to pray for the longevity and well-being of her husband.

The puja song sung by punjabi women, while they exchange thalis seven times...

"Veero Kudiye Karwada, Sarv Suhagan Karwada, A Katti Na Ateri Naa,
Kumbh Chrakhra Feri Naa, Gwand Pair payeen Naa, Sui Che Dhaga Payeen Naa
Ruthda maniyen Naa, Suthra Jagayeen Naa, Bhain Pyari Veeran,
Chan Chade Te Pani Peena Ve Veero Kuriye Karwara, Ve Sarv Suhagan Karwara....."

This Stanza is sung 6 times i.e. It keeps on repeating till the time Thalis have been exchanged and all women have their own thalis... it goes on six times, 6 feras / circles. The seventh fera or circle or exchanging goes like this...

"Veero Kudiye Karwada, Sarv Suhagan Karwada, Aye Katti Naya Teri Nee,
Kumbh Chrakhra Feri Bhee, Aar Pair payeen Bhee, Ruthda maniyen Bhee,
Suthra Jagayeen Bhee, Ve Veero Kuriye Karwara, Ve Sarv Suhagan Karwara....."

Om Namó Bhagavaté Vasudevaya Namah

Remember, our Vedic Rishis words, "All be Happy and be Prosperous". If maximum numbers of people in a society (city, state, or country) are happy, then that society is happy and prosperous.

Beautiful Conversation Between Krishna and Uddhava.

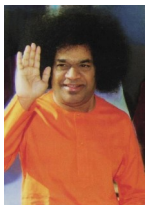
