

Dr. Surindra Gambhir will talk about our relationship with the Universe and with nature. Dr. Kachroo graduated from NJ Medical School and did his fellowship in Neuromuscular Disease& Electrodiagnostic Medicine at Univ. of Vermont. Currently, he is a partner at Advocare Neurology in Lumberton, NJ.


