The day of Karva Chauth is celebrated mostly by married Indian Ladies settled in India and other parts of the world. The most important aspect of this day is that a dawn to dusk fast is undertaken by the married ladies and seeing the moon they finally break the fast. The Karva Chauth fast is unique perhaps because nowhere in the world does a wife go without food or water just to pray for the longevity and well-being of her husband.

Many of you with children in our Sunday school would benefit from longer membership renewal since your kids may potentially have eight years of Bal Vihar and five years of youth program participation ahead of them.
