
HINDU SENIOR CITIZENS - TWO MEETINGS DURING APRIL AT ICC


BalVihar and Yuva Darshan Annual Day

Vallabhacharva her-alded a new era of Bhakti-Marga, which teaches unswerving love toward God admitting everyone in the fold, irrespective of sex, cast or nationality. Pushti Marga, the path of grace as founded by Shri Vallabhacharya is very easy to follow as a way of life by common people. Once you commit yourself to God by ritual of "Brahma-Sambanth", God takes care of you unconditionally. He takes you to Pushti Marga by his teaching of Shrodas-Grantha. In Pushti Margs, Bhakti is not a means, but an end. It is also called Premlakshana Bhakti.

Shri Vallabhcharya's other works include Anu-Bhashya (Commentary on Brahma Sutra), tattva Dipa Nibandha and Subodhini (Commentary on Bhagavata). Vallabha regards Shrimad Bha-gvata as the most authentic work on knowledge of God
